Larry Lemons, President, called meeting to order @ 6:00 pm, Sept 9, '21 Treasurer's Report: \$ 2920.11 (All bills paid) Art News in the community: (As of the posting of these minutes, these events are now over). Tales N' Trails Museum hosted "Shebang" an annual fundraiser for the museum in Nocona, Tx. Clay Co. Art Association had their 63rd Annual Fine Arts Display & Sale on Saturday, Sept. 18th at the Clay County Pioneer Reunion Festival) Current: Randy Meador watercolor workshop is still open. Contact the Davis & Blevins Art Gallery in St. Jo, Texas. (940) 995-2786 V. Kohn mentioned a possible Small Works Christmas Show in Nocona? (Oct Nov)..3 days? Larry Lemons will check on this. Movie Night: in lieu of guest speaker, CTAA had several options for movies. "Loving Vincent" was the feature (popcorn & sodas were provided!). "Loving Vincent" is a 2017 experimental animated biographical drama film about painter Vincent van Gogh. Unfortunately, the sound system at the bank malfunctioned, enabling CTAA members to observe the video movie in silent motion picture form. The movie was entirely painted by 125 classically trained artists from many countries. The artists created 65,000 canvas paintings for animation using Van Gosh's paintings for the film storyboard. The theme of the movie was inspired after an artist, Dorota Kobiela, studied his techniques & the artist's story through his letters. It was a story about Van Gosh's persecuted life, the rejection of his peers & the strange circumstances of his death. Van Gogh was known to have painted over 900 paintings in his lifespan with the sale of only one painting. Ironically his paintings today are worth millions. According to Sostheby's his last painting was auctioned March, 2021 for \$15, 356, 311 U.S. currency! Without audio, watching the movie provide a fresh observation of the skills of the 125 artists from different countries who were able to reproduce the techniques of Van Gogh's style. The animation of the hundreds of paintings were able to capture lifelike facial expressions with his dominant brushwork. Even changing of the seasons and weather patterns of the landscape settings were painted as if by Van Gogh himself. A most unusual artistic form of animation in the form of fine art painters rather than animators! Artist of the Month: We have a tie! 
Randy Meador's 'That's Not Watercolor' Workshop Fri.-Sat., Oct. 22-24
