CTAA Meeting Minutes November 8, 2018

C T AA

President Gale Cochran-Smith called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Attendance record was kept by signing the guest book.

Treasurer's Report by Gwen Coulson reported a bank balance of \$1,105.36, unchanged from last month. Guest speaker, Randy Oberbeck, graciously returned his presenter's fee to the group as a donation.

Discussion was made regarding the CTAA Christmas Party as being either a potluck meal like last year at either the bank or going somewhere else for a meal. Liz Bower is going to research possibly using The Matthews House as a group venue and catered meal, or Spicy Mexico as a venue and meal. White Elephant/Chinese Christmas Gift Exchange was also discussed with a \$25 limit on the wrapped gift to be anonymously exchanged during the party. Jennifer Hammer will send out a group email asking for a vote on (1) potluck meal at the bank, or (2) catered/ordered meal at a restaurant or other venue. The Christmas Party is scheduled for early evening on December 13th.

Discussion was made regarding a CTAA hosted juried art show next year, providing a venue can be found somewhere in Montague County. Gale is going to check with Rusty Fenoglio to see if the building next to the drug store in Nocona will be available. The Justin Community Center is also an option, provided that it is air conditioned by next summer. More research will need to be done and decisions made not later than January on order to host a successful art show.

Progress report was made by Larry Lemons regarding using space in his gallery that is currently not being use for CTAA members' art displays. A roof leak has delayed that option, and it is hoped that will be resolved by year end.

The majority of members' dues are due in January/February. Officers are up for voting in the next meeting, and ALL officer positions are open. The group was encouraged to volunteer to replace officers currently holding office for a number of years.

Larry introduced our guest artist, Randy Oberbeck, an air brush artist who is currently exhibiting at the 802 Gallery in Decatur and is in the process of opening his own art gallery in downtown Bridgeport next to Ann Ayres Gallery. Randy has only been working in air brush art for a short time, starting with painting motorcycles and pilot's helmets for the fighter pilots at Sheperd's Air Force Base. He built a successful business by word of mouth, and was able to start his own business and quit his day job at GE. He won Best of Show for his motorcycle art at the World of Wheels Show in Wichita Falls. Caustic chemicals in automotive lacquer paints led Randy to change to the art of air brushing on canvas, and he developed his own unique methods of prepping canvas to accept the air brush more evenly. He uses layering, masking techniques, scrubbing and scratching techniques to get the fine details in his paintings, which are based on his own photographs or that of friends. His paintings show amazing realism and have received strong praise in several art communities. We see a field trip in our future to his new gallery in Bridgeport!


