Our celebrity judges will be awarding the **Art Fest Best of Show Award** at 5pm! **Proceeds from Art Fest will benefit The Boys & Girls Clubs of Cooke County, Inc.**

We encourage artists of all mediums to join us **Saturday September 21st, 2019!** We are accepting a wide range of artists and mediums including but not limited to fine art, pottery, photography, jewelry. If you have questions or don't see a category that matches your style, please feel free to contact us!

Booth Information:
Booth spaces are \$45 each. We provide a 10x10 space for you to setup as needed. Artists are responsible for their own tent and materials. We encourage tents for protection from the sun, heat, and any other weather. Please be sure to have weights and proper security for your tent to avoid damage or injury. There are no rules on tent color or style, so long as your setup fits within your allotted space. Artists can purchase multiple booths. Fees are non-refundable. Our event is held rain or shine but there will be an indoor alternative in the event of inclement weather. Setup begins at 8am the show begins at 10am. No displays should be dismantled before closing time. Booth numbers will be distributed to each vendor 1 week prior to the event. Please display this number the day of the festival.

Rules:
Only exhibitors who are selling their own handmade items will be accepted. No kits, imports, manufactured, or retail merchandise will be accepted. If you display items that are not handmade, you will be asked to leave and forfeit your booth fee. Accepted vendors must be present for the entire event. Jury decisions are based on creativity, marketability, quality of workmanship, and balance of craft media for a broad public appeal.

Please submit 4 photos of your work and one of your booth setup. Photos should include a description of the work and price ranges. Items offered on the day of the show must be consistent with the items juried. Booth must look neat and professional. All applicants must submit photos. Your information will be published on our website. We may also use your artwork and information in ads, social media, and more!

Size restriction for hanging art: 36" x 36".

The LG Lemons Gallery, 300 Clay St, Nocona, TX 76255, will be accepting the deliveries of the artwork beginning

October 3rd - 9th, from 10 am to 5 pm.

All Artwork must be for sale, wired (no sawtooth hangers) for hanging and labeled on the back with the artist's contact information, title of the piece and price of the piece.

ALL artwork not sold needs to be picked up on Sunday October 13th, 2019 at the Justin Building between 12 pm and 2 pm.

A 20% commission per sale will be split 50/50 with the CTAA and LG Lemons Gallery who will process the sales.

The CTAA, Nocona Nights, LG Lemons Gallery & Nocona Chamber of Commerce are not responsible for any damage to the entries. Artists are responsible for providing their own insurance if they deem necessary. If you ship your artwork, it must be protected adequately and include the return, pre-paid shipping label in the box.

Rick D. Mahaffey Gourd Artist



Rick D Mahaffey, from Cache, OK, will be sharing his beautiful gourd art, including Native American inspired designs that require hours of tedious painting and hand stitching with pine needles. He will show his own personal examples and demonstrate some of the process involved in creating such unusual pieces of art. In addition, he loves writing cowboy poetry and will share a few poems, as time permits.

Rick lives between Cache and Lawton with his wife Rhonda, two dogs and three cats on only a short distance from the buffalo and longhorn herds of the Wichita Mountains. After retiring from 36 years in the public school system as teacher, coach, administrator, and mentor to many young people, he spends time making art and supporting the art community in the Lawton/Cache area. He is a graduate of Ardmore High School, followed by a BS in Education from Cameron University and Masters of Ed. Administration from East Central University.

In his own words, "I took my first art class in the sixth grade at Terral, OK, and gave my first oil painting to my grandmother, S. T. Lemons of Ringgold, Texas. I have painted cow skulls with acrylics, tole painted, braided macrame, and paracord, and created dream catchers out of whiskey barrel rings. My current interest is creating gourd art using alcohol ink and pine needles. I have studied with Master Artist John Hernandez, Director of the Great Plains Museum in Lawton. I also love to write cowboy poetry. Between gourds, poetry, and mowing my grass I can keep my Retired Soul pretty busy."

Rick was born in Nocona, Texas in January 1950, spent most of his childhood in Ringgold, Texas where he learned about the Cowboy Way of Life from his grandfather who raised cattle and hogs. His inspiration to begin writing cowboy inspired poetry came from older brother, Ronnie.

As Rick loves to say, "Drive safely, have a great day, and don't forget to close the gate."
