A 20% commission per sale will be split 50/50 with the CTAA and LG Lemons Gallery who will process the sales.

Artists are responsible for providing their own insurance if they deem necessary. If you ship your artwork, it must be protected adequately and include the return, pre-paid shipping label in the box.
