CTAA February Meeting Minutes

CTAA Meeting Minutes

February 14, 2019

President Gale opened the meeting and requested updates on Rita Rae Dyer (stroke), and Joan Cantwell's daughter/Judy Gelfert's sister who was punched in the face in downtown Ft Worth, by a man, who was out of jail after serving time for previous assault charges. The man has attacked defenseless women on several other occasions, only being charged with a misdemeanor, and then quickly being released back on the street to attack again. We have asked people to support HB 1088, which will change repeated offenses to a felony charge, instead of a misdemeanor.

Rita has been doing somewhat better, but is still having a problem with afib. Her cardiologist has changed her to a different medication, trying to control the afib. We'll keep everyone updated as we know more about her progress.

The Treasurer's report showed \$3,161.00, with \$1,311.59 in our regular account, and \$1,850.00 in the Soon Warren account.

Gale and Larry discussed the following CTAA schedule for the rest of the year:

Reminder that the CTAA juried art show will be held in Larry Lemmon's Studio in Nocona. The theme is Native American. The juried show will run from May 3 – May 10 to coincide with Crusin' Nocona (May 2-4). Deadline for entry will be April 1, with entry acceptance notification by April 17. All entries will be delivered April 26-28. The entries will be hung April 28 – 29. Judging will be April 30 - May 1. Opening Reception for the juried show will be May 4 from 2-5pm. All work must be picked up May 11-12. Further information and entry forms will be provided after the holidays.

Jennifer Hammer's reception for her OPOMAC show will be held on March 9 from 1-3 pm, at the OPOMAC in Graham. CTAA will hold the March meeting at that reception. Please note your calendars. For ride share, meet at the Wellington Bank in Bowie at 10 am.

Gale will have a solo show at the Forum in Wichita Falls, from March 1 through May 11. We will hold the April CTAA meeting as a field trip to the Forum on April 20. Meet at the Wellington Bank in Bowie at 11:30am for ride share.

On May 4, the CTAA will meet at the opening reception for the CTAA Juried Art Show, from 2-5pm, 300 Clay St in Nocona.

The CTAA agenda for the meeting on June 13 will be announced at a later date.

July 11, will be a CTAA Field Trip to the Chisholm Trail Heritage Center, Duncan, OK, for the opening reception for Larry Lemon's solo show, from 3:00 – 5:30pm.

8th Annual Art at the OPOMAC National Art Show

ART at the OPOMAC 2019

June 22nd - July 27th, 2019

Awards Reception: June 22nd, 2019

ELIGIBILITY: This is a national competition open to all artists 21 years of age and over. Artwork must not have been shown previously at the Old Post Office Museum and Art Center, including being displayed at any time or entered in any competition at the OPOMAC.

FORMAT: Original 2 and 3-dimensional art only. No photography, prints, or computer-generated artwork will be accepted. No artwork over 2 years old may be shown.

SIZE: The boundary measurement of framed art shall not exceed 120 inches.

SHOW AWARDS: \$4,500 worth of prizes - Best in Show - \$2,000.00

SUBMISSION & DEADLINE: Entries must be made to OnlineJuriedShows.com by

May 1, 2019. All information about entries can be obtained through the web site. For questions about the online computer entry procedure you may call the OPOMAC at 940-549-1470.

ENTRY FEE: The entry fee is \$30.00 for the first entry, \$45.00 for two pieces, and \$60.00 for a maximum of three pieces, and shall be paid online at onlinejuriedshows.com upon entry.

Juror: Randy Meador

Randy Meador is a wholly self-taught artist without instruction except his own exhaustive study of works by Winslow Homer, John Singer Sargent, Nicolai Fechin, and Joaquin Sorolla.

Born just a stone's throw from the Waggoner Ranch in Vernon, Texas and raised on a smaller ranch in Central West Texas, he fell in love with the hues of the West and returned to those hues in 2007 as a full-time artist.

Randy lives in Saint Jo, Texas with his wife and two remaining children (of five).

In 2012 Randy began accepting workshop and demo requests. His animated and unorthodox stage presentations are currently being developed into a syndicated television show.
