Seventh Day Adventist Church in Bowie was suggested. Gale C. Smith nominated motion to meet at church with R.S.V.P. for members. Time: our standard meeting time... 2nd Thursday (Dec 9th). Members' money needed for catering before party. There will be a White Elephant exchange. Larry suggested that we also have live Christmas music with instruments. **Guest Artist: Vonnie Kohn** Ms. Kohn filled in as a guest artist for the previously scheduled artist who was unable to come. She comes with an established record as a Nationally recognized professional artist with many years of experience. Working in various media, oil was chosen as the demonstration for CTAA. She brought some examples of Western, Native American, Landscape, & Inspirational Artwork to view. A brother provided her with a photo of a champion chuck wagon cook which she demonstrated for our group. Having oil sketch (with a brush) the model, she prepared the canvas with a neutral acrylic wash to diminish the stark white background. Applying the darkest darks first, the background was painted, then the underlying colors of the painting began. During the process, she explained how to paint with turps to speed up the drying time of the underpainting. It was a method she learned while doing national paint-outs which were timed as one-two hour sessions in competition. She offered several tips for treating the canvas for preparation to paint. She stretches her own canvas, applies 3-5 coats of Gesso, sanding between the 4-5 layers. Value & shape are keys to the foundation blocks of a successful painting. Drawing thumbnails and a color study sets the composition. There will be an additional layer of paint applied before the painting is finished.
