

It will be a book signing/presentation by Bridgeport author/photographer Alyssa Banta for her new book "The Texas Ranch Sisterhood: Portraits of Women Working the Land." - In lieu of our October meeting, we will host the Opening Reception for the Art of the Song Art Show. Larry suggested that The Minds' Eye could provide rock and roll music after the reception, with acoustic music during the reception. He will let us know when Nocona Nights has their next meeting on planning for the music festival and art show.
- Gale talked about the abysmal level of participation this year for the Shoebox Float Contest during Nocona's Mardi Gras Celebration and urged all members to participate next year (there is an adult catagory as well as kids' categories). To help our participation, she proposed our November meeting to be a "hands on" decorating session, with members urged to obtain a shoebox before then to be decorated during our meeting.

Gale Cochran-Smith then proceeded with a PowerPoint presentation about how she created the illustrations for a book soon to be published for a friend of hers in California. It is the story of his 4X Great Grandfather who was a Franciscan Priest in the early California mission system of the 1800s. She talked about researching the subject matter so that the illustrations could be as historically accurate as possible, copyright restrictions, and the need to "change up" her reference photos so as to result in individually unique illustrations. She chose 5 of the 21 illustrations for the book to use in a demonstration on her methods of creating a final illustration. Gale also talked about self-publishing through Amazon's Kindle Direct Publishing, and other publishers who assist authors for a fee, how "print-on-demand" works, and how both methods differ. Gale mentionned that she had published several books herself, as well as assisted others in doing so.

Our "free" projector doesn't have the ability to focus very accurately, so discussion was also made about the CTAA purchasing a different projector to be used for our meeting demonstrations. This would be especially necessary for photographic and other fine art presentations. Larry is to take on the task of researching options available in the \$200-\$400 price range.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:25pm

### CTAA March Meeting Gale Cochran-Smith


















CTAA President Gale Cochran-Smith brought us an in-depth presentation on what she does when she illustrates and publishes books. Gale has been publishing books for herself and other people for years. The book she talked about during her presentation was for a person who has





written a book about his 4X Great Grandfather, a Franciscan Priest in early 1800's California.



Gale's watercolor illustrations fill the book and she explained the process of how she creates the illustrations. It's a process that requires hours and hours of research to reflect the period in which the story takes place.



Gale explained the differences in certain ways to publish books. The service she uses if she is doing the publishing is through Amazon's Kindle Direct

Publishing. There are other services that are based on fees and print-on-demand types.






