

Page 2 Guest Artist: Johnny Bone Johnny Bone is an artist involved in many talents-painter, musician, & film industry background. While living in Franklin, Tn, he studied for 4 years at Southgate Studio under the tutelage of Jody Thompson (mentored by Daniel Green, foremost contemporary artist from New York City). Mr. Bone, originally from Bridgeport, Tx now lives in Marietta, Oklahoma. He worked from a live model, Mr. Ross McCourtie, from Azle, Tx. Beginning with a toned background of cradled hardboard, he very quickly established the image beginning with the eyes & a plumb line. His pallet was glass with gray painted on the back to correct his paint value. Using the "fat over lean" method, his medium was initially turpentine. Also using the "sight & size" method, he began the foundation of "mood." He intuitively sensed whether the painting was working as he

continued to portray a remarkable

likeness of the model. Johnny's preferred paints are Michael Harding, which has a buttery feel of application for painting. He uses several brushes to help keep his paints clean. Preferred brushes are "flats" for painting, "rounds" for drawing. He also uses charcoal to draw, sprays with fixative, glazes with thinned paint, then removes with a rag to achieve values. His favorite medium is Chelsea "lean" medium. Subject matter includes "Red River" landscapes & Native Americans. Of Native descent, he seems to paint the soul of Native Americans. His successful art career is based on "word of mouth" and sales through social media (Facebook). The painting was completed in Sepia tones and was a successful likeness. Beginning Portraiture with Judy Gelfert

Learn the art of portraiture with artist Judy Gelfert. In this workshop, Judy will reveal the secrets of drawing and painting portraits by breaking down a seemingly difficult subject into more easily understood concepts. We will learn the general shapes and dimensions of the human head and features and will learn about capturing likeness by concentrating on the fundamentals of oil painting, including shapes, values, color intensity and neutrals, and paint application and manipulation. Judy will do a demonstration to begin the workshop, and students will then paint a portrait of their choosing from their own photograph or one of Judy's. Students will receive individual attention throughout the workshop.
