

Lake Country Art Show In Graham, TX

Paid-up members of local art clubs or guilds are encouraged to enter our annual Lake Country Show in Graham, hosted by the Graham Art Guild and presented at the Old Post Office Museum and Art Center (OPOMAC) on the town square's south side. The show will hang from July 26 through August 31 at 510 3rd Street in Graham, Tx. Registration at the OPOMAC - 9 to 4 July 21 & 22 The show will hang from July 26 through August 26 Reception - August 26 from 1 to 3 Pickup Artwork - after 2:30 August 26 \$40 entry fee for up to 3 pieces Each additional entry is \$15 °°° Oils & Acrylics - Pencil / Pen / Pastels Watercolors - 3D (stand-alone pieces) - Mixed Media Works Digital Works (including Photography) Classwork (classwork must be marked as such; it is eligible for ribbon awards but not cash awards.) °°° All artwork must be original, created within the last two years, and has not been shown at the OPOMAC previously. Pieces must be framed or on gallery-wrapped canvas or board...All must be wired for hanging - no sawtooth hangers or masking tape, please. Pieces must be for sale; there shall be a 20% commission paid to the Graham Art Guild on all sales. Although great care is taken to protect your artwork during the hanging of the show, the museum and the art guild cannot be held responsible for any accidental damage.
