CTAA May Minutes

Meeting May 11, 2023

Meeting called to order at 6:05pm at Wellington State Bank in Bowie, Texas, by Gale Smith

As Gwen and Jesse Coulson are currently on vacation, Gale gave the bank balance as of that morning as \$2,602.01.

There has been a change in June's meeting presenter, as Cara Lea Willoughby will be unable to give the presentation because of another commitment. Instead, her friend Davina Andre will give a talk on marketing for artists, beginning with logo design and websites.

July's meeting will be Johnny Bone; August meeting will be an art museum field trip, and September meeting will be a presentation of the art of Barcelona by the Coulsons.

Gale announced that there is one opening for Soon Warren's Watercolor workshop on June 7,8 & 9, as we had one cancellation. Refund is pending if we can fill the spot.

The deadline for the Kemp Center's Mystery Art Show has been moved up to August 24th, with the show running from October 7th thru the 26th. Members are encouraged to submit an 8"x10" "mystery" piece to support the Kemp.

Discussion was made concerning the Art of the Song art show categories, and it was decided to add one more category splitting mixed media/glass/textiles from sculpture, gourds, and other types of 3-D art. Painting will consist of oil and any water media; Drawing will consist of pastel, chalk, pencil, ink. Gale will give Jennifer the information to do a flyer, prospectus, etc for the show. Prize money will be the same as last year, other than adding an additional category.

The presentation was made by Marsha Wright-Reeves on her epoxy art. She began with trying to create a piece that looked like one of her stained glass pieces, but wasn't, and she came up with the idea of printing out an image of the stained glass and then doing a clear epoxy pour over the top of it. From there she branched out to other permutations of art using epoxy, including using it with alcohol inks - where she explained the difference between transparent and more opaque inks and their useage.

Marsha talked about her trial and error process of learning how to use epoxies, including watching hours and hours of YouTube videos. She told us several things NOT to do! She explained that she is still learning about the medium and feels there is lots of potential for creating unusual art that no one else is doing.

Meeting then adjourned to the hallway as tornado sirens, phone alarms, and police car sirens warned of an approaching tornado. We spent roughly 20 minutes in the hallway before the "all clear" was given, and the meeting was adjourned. No damage reported in the area, although very heavy rain was reported and several funnel clouds were spotted. An interesting end to a meeting!





