#### Beginning Portraiture with Judy Gelfert

Learn the art of portraiture with artist Judy Gelfert. In this workshop, Judy will reveal the secrets of drawing and painting portraits by breaking down a seemingly difficult subject into more easily understood concepts. We will learn the general shapes and dimensions of the human head and features and will learn about capturing likeness by concentrating on the fundamentals of oil painting, including shapes, values, color intensity and neutrals, and paint application and manipulation. Judy will do a demonstration to begin the workshop, and students will then paint a portrait of their choosing from their own photograph or one of Judy's.
