The 6th Annual *Cowboy True Art Exhibit & Auction* will take place in Wichita Falls, TX on March 31 & April 1, 2017. The juring committee for this exhibit is now accepting applications and has invited you to submit your pieces for consideration.

Enclosed you will find the 2017 guidelines and application.

Cowboy True has a big announcement! We have listened to our artists' feedback and are excited to announce the addition of a *\$500 cash prize award for 1st place* in each category!

The exhibit categories include **bits, spurs, buckles, jewelry, gum/knife engraving, saddles, boots, trappings/gear, photography, paintings, drawings, sculptures, carving, cowboy cartoons, and pottery.** We also have a new open category; if there are not enough entries in the above categories, your work will be placed in the "open" category for judging. To be considered for inclusion in this juried exhibit, please submit the enclosed application, high-resolution photographs of your cowboy art or gear, and a photograph and biography of yourself to cowboytrue@theforumwf.org or mail to 2120 Speedway Avenue, Wichita Falls, TX 76308, or you may apply online at artscouncilwf.org.

The juring deadlines are as follows:

- September 15, 2016
- November 15, 2016
- January 15, 2017
- February 15, 2017

Applications must be in by the deadline to be considered at that date. Notification of selection will take up to 2 weeks after the deadline date. If selected, you will be invoiced for your booth fee of \$150.00 (please do not send entry fee with application). The Cowboy True juring committee reserves the right to hold an application until a future juring date.
