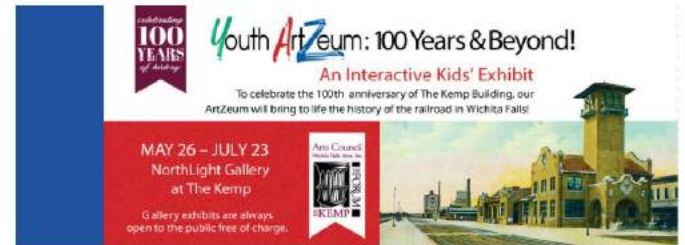

Pencil/Pen•Experimental Works

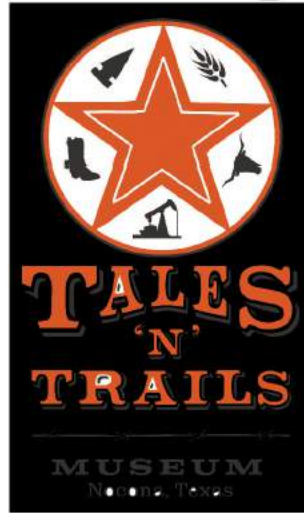
Classwork must be marked as such. It will be juried separately.

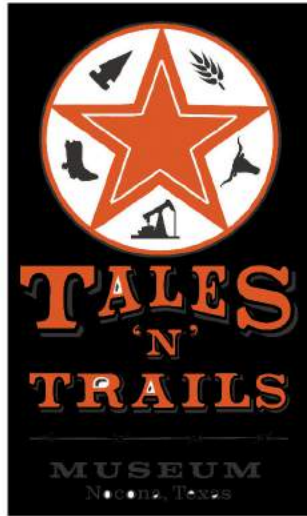
