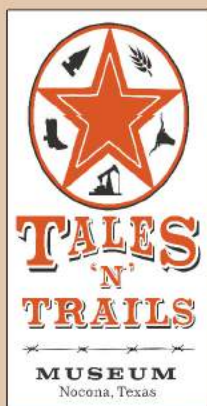

Quick Start to Stained Glass - June 2nd

Come learn the basics of stained glass while creating a lovely stained glass sun-catcher. Learn the art of glass cutting, grinding, copper foiling, soldering and patina. Each person will create their own design using stained glass, glass nuggets and wire.

Watercolor Workshop - June 16, 2018 Instructor: Barry Selman, Granbury, TX

After painting with watercolor for the last 40 years, I (Barry) think I've finally gotten the hang of it. I have developed a style that I can identify with, and when needed, I can vary it to create several different effects. Over the last few years, I have been able to study with several nationally known watercolor artists and with each new encounter, I have been able to adapt new techniques improving my painting skills.

In this class, I will teach watercolor basics of design, composition, value, balance and harmony. I also teach watercolor fundamentals such as gradation, positive/negative painting wet on wet technique, variation of shapes and the use of oblique angles. Students may already understand these principles, but I find, I still learn something new each time.

If you are a paid-up member of your local art club or guild, you are welcome to enter our annual Lake Country Show in Graham, hosted by the Graham Art Guild and presented at the Old Post Office Museum and Art Center (OPOMAC). The show will hang from August 3 - 31st.

Registration at the OPOMAC - 9 to 4 August 1 & 2

Reception at the OPOMAC - August 4- 2:00 to 4:00

Pickup Artwork all day August 31st

Limit 5 entries per person; \$30 entry fee for up to 5 pieces

Oils • Acrylics • Watercolors
Pastels • 3-Dimensional Works • Photography
Pencil/Pen • Experimental Works

Classwork must be marked as such; classwork is eligible for ribbon awards but not cash awards.

All artwork must be original, created within the last two years, and not have been shown at the OPOMAC previously. Pieces must be framed or on gallery- wrapped canvas or board; ALL must be wired for hanging - no sawtooth hangers or masking tape.

Pieces must be for sale; there shall be a 20% commission paid to the Graham Art Guild on all sales.

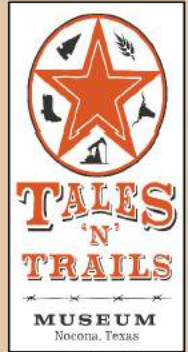

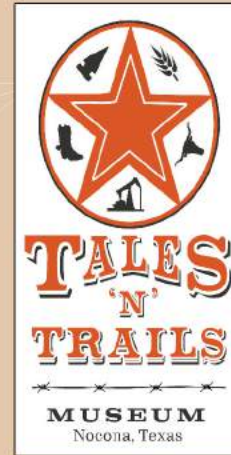
