

Gale Cochran-Smith called to order the business meeting of the Chisholm Trail Art Association (CTAA) at the Chisholm Trail Room at the Wellington State Bank in Bowie at 6pm.

Roll Call/Minutes/Treasurer's Report:

- a. No minutes were read for the prior meeting which was held on February 11, 2016.
- b. Each member present at this meeting signed the guest book in lieu of roll call.
- c. Bank balance as of February 29, 2016 was \$1,387.71.

Business:

- a. Jack Milchanowski reported that so far he has two scholarship applicants--one from Bowie High School and the other from Nocona High School.
- b. A motion was made by Jack Milchanowski that we will commit to a three-day workshop by Soon Y Warren after receiving a great review by Gale Cochran-Smith who had attended a workshop. Cost will be \$150.00 for the three days. The workshop will take place on June 22, 23, and 24. We need as many members as possible to sign up. Brenda Thompson seconded the motion. Motion carried. - c. President Cochran-Smith made an urgent request for a demonstration mirror. Many guest artists require such a mirror. Approximate cost would be in the \$200-\$350 range. Jesse Coulson made the motion to purchase and Celia Ashley second the motion. Motion carried.
- d. Beth Hiatt of Bowie Public Library is looking for summer programs for children 7 years old and up. Anyone interested needs to see Beth Hiatt.
- e. Appreciation is given to President Cochran-Smith for her signage with the Bowie Knife Project on behalf of CTAA.

May, Beth Pritchart, pastel demonstration; June, field trip to Brenda Thompsons Vineyard, July, field trip to Gale Cochran-Smith's ranch; August, field trip to Amon Carter Museum, Fort Worth.
- g. The program presenter was Gale Cochran-Smith who did a presentation on watercolor
- "Artist of the Month" was voted on, and by a majority vote named Brenda Thompson.


RSARY 2016 JURIED



"Paint the Glen" Paint Out 8th Annual Glen Rose Plein Air Event April 8th and 9th, 2016

Sponsored by the Convention and Visitors Bureau, the Somervell History Foundation, Barnard's Mill Art League and White Buffalo Gallery

ENTRIES: Pre-registration application may be mailed (Completed form and \$25.00 check or money order maybe payable to: Barnard's Mill Art League, 105 Summit View, Glen Rose, Texas 76043. After April 1, 2016 \$35.00) Entries may be made at the door day of the event.

CHECK-IN: Artist may check-in starting at 7:30 on Saturday, April 18 at Barnard's Mill and Art Museum, 307 SW Barnard St., Glen Rose, Texas 76043. ALL artists must have their boards, paper, canvas, etc. stamped starting at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday at the check in area prior to any work being done. Images may not exceed 30 X 30 inches. Only One Entry to be judged per person but 3 items can be stamped at check-in. All work must be done outside during this prescribed period of time.

PAINTING BOUNDARIES: Artist is responsible for selecting their paint out locations in the designated area (map provided with city limit boundaries clearly marked. This area includes the Historic District, downtown square, Heritage, Park, Oakdale Park, and the area inside the city limit boundaries. Artists will be very aware of private property and will in fact be responsible for asking permission to paint private homes. We have many "paintable" areas to choose from.

SALE/EXHIBIT AND RECEPTION: participating artists will be allowed to display up to three pieces of artwork created during the day event. Tables will be provided. Artists are encouraged to bring table & floor easels. Artwork may be framed or unframed. All unsold paintings must be picked up at the end of the sale and exhibit. This year our Judge will R. Gregory Summers from Overland Park, Kansas a recognized Plein Air painter in his own right.

<u>COMMISSION:</u> Barnard's Mill Art League will retain a commission of 25% of any artwork sold. The buyer will make a check out to Barnard's Mill Art League and the Barnard's Mill Art League will issue and mail a check to the artist within ten days.

OPPORTUNITY FOR ARTISTS: Artists may display/sell prior works (paintings, notecards, prints, etc.) at the easel location, but not at the exhibit/sale. There will be no outdoor display space. Only artwork created during the paint out may be submitted for the sale/exhibit.

ELIGIBILITY: Any artist at any skill level may enter. All work must be done outside, in the defined area.

<u>LIABILITY:</u> We suggest that artists carry their own insurance. All reasonable care will be taken with original artwork. BMAL will not be responsible for the loss or damage of any work. Entry shall imply an agreement on the part of the artist.

1st prize \$500.00

2nd prize \$250.00

3rd prize \$100.00

Additional Honorable Mention recognition will be given




