

Chisholm Trail Art Association Meeting Minutes March 9, 2017

President Gale Cochran-Smith opened the meeting. There were his presentation.

- Gale reminded all that dues were due based on your month of joining – to check the membership roster
- The Treasurer's report showed we had \$664.20 in the treasury
- Scholarship Chair, Jack Milchanowski, said no student has yet applied for the scholarship. He's reminded all teachers of the April 3 deadline.
- More discussion on the CTAA juried Western Art Show and Sale. Deadline for entries is June 1, 2017. The show runs from July 1-August 15, 2017. The CTAA July meeting will be the opening reception for the Art Show.
- Considering a June trip to the Kimball Art Museum for the June meeting. All were asked to respond to Larry by email of their interest in the trip.
- Soon Warren's workshop is full at 16 attendees, with 5 on the waiting list. Gale said she would look at trying to add another table to the workshop.
- Bowie will be having a cattle drive to celebrate Chisholm Trail days on Saturday, April 22. Will start at the Bowie knife in the morning on April 22, and will end up coming down Hwy 81. They will offer lunch and a chuckwagon dinner. They will need guides if Gale Cochran-Smith won Artist of the Month for her watercolor of anyone is interested in helping.
- Larry Lemons mentioned that he had been on TV discussing his art in an interview with TX Reporter. He said the interview will eventually go on RFD. He discussed selling his art any way he can and encouraged all of us to do the same.
- Jack Milchanowski discussed the Cowboy True Art Show

being held at the J.S. Bridwell AG Center in Wichita Falls, TX, March 31-April 1, 2017. The exhibit and events on Saturday, April 1 are free to the public.

Gale then introduced the evening's presenter, Ben Jacobi. some general comments before our guest artist, Ben Jacobi, gave Ben Jacobi from Wichita Falls, is a Weather/Nature Photographer and a Storm Chaser. He said he was always fascinated with weather changes and Thunderstorms, and at 14 he started getting serious about photography. He mostly focuses on nature and landscape photography, but really enjoys photographing severe weather and the night sky. He started his presentation with ""Storm chasing is 98% frustration, aggravation, and depression and 2% pure adrenaline and insanity". Ben said that was the best way he could describe it. The majority of his storm chases are usually spent driving to the target area and waiting (and hoping) storms initiate. He gave a good presentation on what he looks for when storm chasing (moisture, lift, buoyancy), and did mention that the most dangerous situations are the other drivers. Zachry has been honored as Abilene's Outstanding Citizen, Outstanding Businessperson, Abilene's Distinguished Citizen and has received its Hero of Tourism award as well as the Volunteer Service Award.
