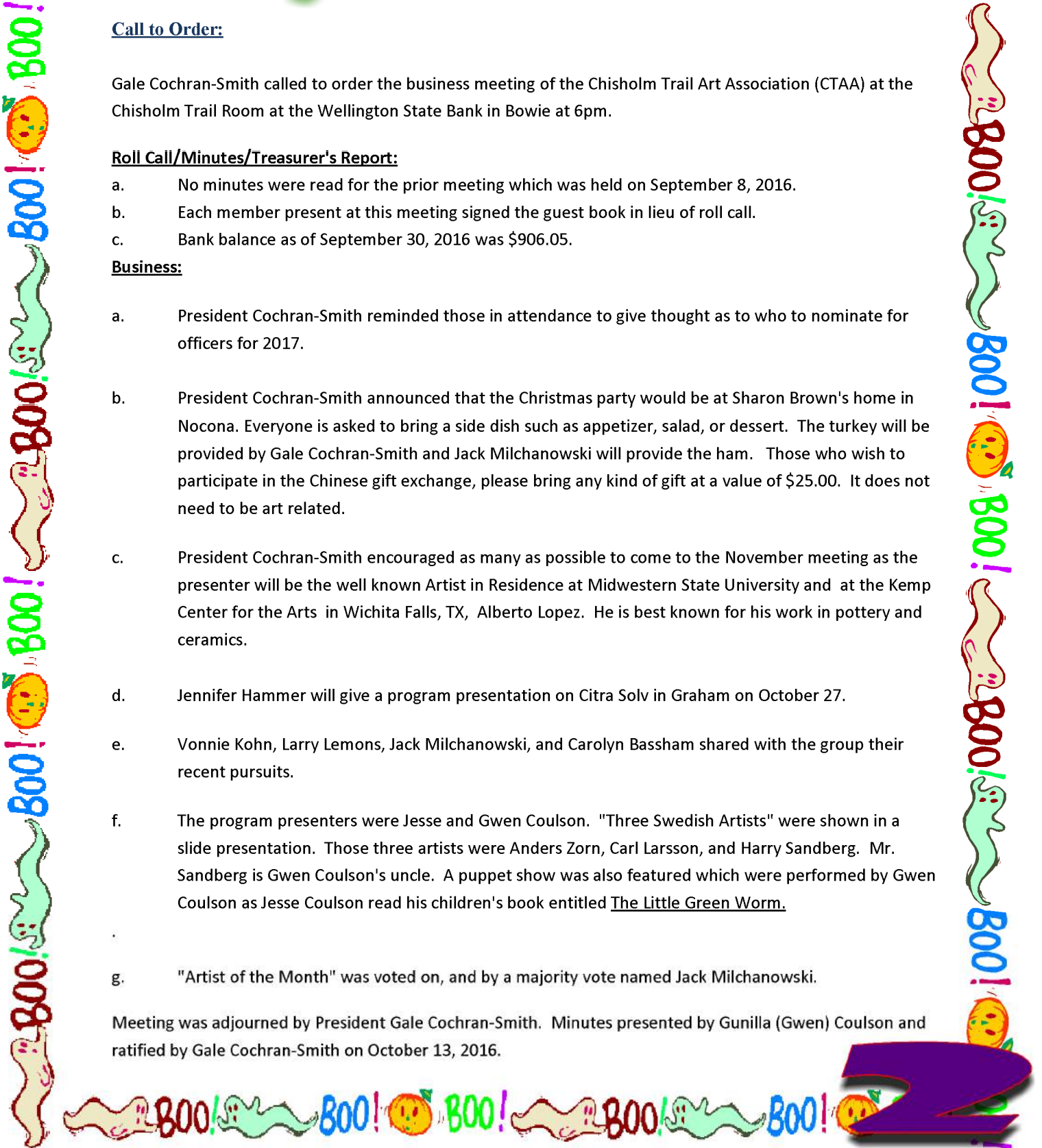
## Roll Call/Minutes/Treasurer's Report:

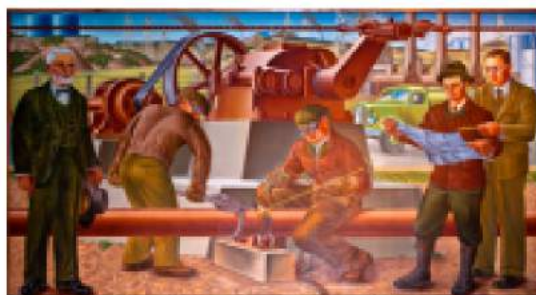

The show primarily provides a special annual exhibition for members of all art clubs in the North Texas area. The art clubs provide pre-juried art to the Arte de los Brazos art show which is then further judged for awards by the recognized artist from the North Texas area. Although the show is directed toward art club entries which are eligible for awards, selected established artist from the area are also invited to participate as specially showcased artist. The artwork of the invited artists are displayed in a special features selection but not judged.

This is our way of recognizing those accomplished professional artists who have generously provided demonstration, art classes and other support to the emerging artists of the art club organizations in our area.

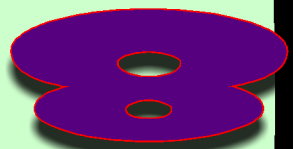

# CTAA RECIPES

## Mother's Garlic Spareribs From Gale Cochran-Smith

4 Tbsp white sugar  
1 Tbsp salt  
4 Tbsp honey  
3 tsp soy sauce  
3 Tbsp beef consomme (or more)  
2 lbs pork spareribs, cut into individual pieces  
3 cloves garlic, minced

Mix sugar, salt, honey, soy sauce & consomme in a bowl. Place spareribs into this mixture and roll to cover each piece. Top with garlic. Cover bowl and let stand in fridge 12 - 24 hours, mixing occasionally so that all pieces are coated.

Cook 30 min at 400 degrees, turn and cook 30 more minutes, lowering heat to 350 degrees if browning too fast. Serve with steamed rice.

## Ice Box Ginger Muffins

1 cup Crisco	1 ¾ tsp soda
1 cup sugar	3 tsp ginger
1 cup buttermilk	1 tsp nutmeg
1 cup molasses	2 tsp cinnamon
3 eggs	½ tsp salt
3 cups flour	

Cream together the Crisco & sugar. Add the eggs and molasses. Alternately add the buttermilk with the dry ingredients.

To cook:

425° till done. About 10 to 15 minutes.

This batter will keep in the fridge for a week or more.
