Guest Artist: Ann Ayers, sculptor Ann Ayers is known as a storyteller, writer, teacher, sculptor with many accomplishments. She has had the privilege of creating bronzes of well known celebrities such as Buck Taylor ("Gunsmoke" fame), Sam Houston, legendary fireman, Shakey Holder, of Irving, Tx (# 1 fireman in the USA), Pioneer Cowgirls such as Bonnie McCarroll, Florence Hughes Randolph, and Velda Tindall Smith, Ruth Roach, and Garlene Tildall Parrish, youngest trick rider who was riding at 10 years old! Ann also authored a book about Bonnie McCarroll, based on her own words from several newspaper interviews. The book was illustrated by Gale Cochran Smith. The title of the book is, "The Girl Who Wanted to Ride Buckers." She also enjoys teaching children (the next generation) how to sculpt. The Process: Ann then described the process of casting bronzes using the "lost wax method," so specialized that she uses two different foundries to produce her sculpture. The process begins with a wire armature, followed by clay modeling, then covered with a rubber mold (in thin layers, drying completely before adding the next layer). The next step goes through "wax chasers," those who remove imperfections in the wax model, then to the silicone room where the waxes are dipped in several layers to build a hard crusted shell that will go through the process of pouring liquid bronze metal into the shell. At this point, the wax melts & drains out leaving the bronze statue. The process is still not finished...sandblasting & refinement in the "metal" room followed by a stain known as patina is added while metal statue is reheated to open the pores of the metal to accept the patina. The statue is then attached to a marble or wooden base to complement the artwork. A final polishing of the statue completes the process. Ann has had some upcoming projects in the works...The Wise County Veteran's Museum in Bridgeport, Tx houses "Letters from Home", a life size sculpture of a military man, bare chested & wearing his id tags (dog tags), is sitting & reading letters from his family. Another accomplishment was a sculpture of Bonnie McCarroll, a part of the permanent collection in the Cowboy Hall of Fame in Oklahoma City. Upcoming projects: She has a tentative life-size project in Denison, Tx of a Series of 4 kids, who became notable in life, one being Scully Sullenberger, the pilot who successfully landed a plane in the New York harbor after engine failure with no fatalities! Scully is from Denison. Another current project includes a dancer who is arched backward in a complete circle with her hair almost touching the lower part of her leg. We look forward to images of this figure! Ann is currently represented at the Cool Creek Art Gallery, 1018 Halsell St., Bridgeport, Tx. 940-368-4575. We want to thank Ann for a very entertaining & instructive overview into the world of Bronze & the challenges it presents. Meeting was concluded at 7:30 pm.
