Monthly Meeting Minutes

October 9, 2014



Call to Order:

Gunilla Coulson, Secretary/Treasurer called to order the business meeting of the Chisholm Trail Art Association (CTAA) at the Chisholm Trail

- b. Each member present at this meeting signed the guest book in lieu of roll call.
 - c. Bank balance was \$784.66.

Business:

a. Jack Milchanowski announced the November 1, 2014 Small America Art Show sponsored by the Bowie Alliance for Education and the Arts which will be held at the United Methodist Church in Bowie. Set-up time is 3 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., Friday, October 31, 2014 and Saturday morning from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Judging will take place at 11:00 a.m. on November 1. The Awards Reception will be at 3:00 p.m. Adult cost is \$25 for 3 entries; \$5 for each additional entry. Youth cost is \$10.00 for 3 entries and \$2 for each additional entry.

Art must be framed with wire hanger. BAEA has the right to exclude any piece considered an unsuitable subject. Any work sold during the show will have a 20% donation deducted for BAEA scholarship fund.

- b. The art show held in the Bowie Public Library is held over until October 31, 2014.
- c. The meeting consisted of a presentation by Cynthia Westbook who gave a demonstration on gel printing. All those who desired were given the opportunity to do a hands-on painting.
 - d. There was no "Artist of the Month" entry at this meeting.


DEADLINE FOR ENTRY IS MARCH 28th, 2015 for the 4th Annual
